DAR ES SALAAM CITY TOUR

Highlights

- The tour offers a look at daily activities in Dar Es Salaam.
- Drive through the city center and toward Mnazi Moja Park, where a replica of the Uhuru Torch Monument is located.
- The original monument was erected on Mt. Kilimanjaro to commemorate freedom from colonialism.
- The tour will also take visitors to the Village museum, Tinganga market, the Mwenge Carvings Market, and the National Museum.
- At the National Museum, visitors can see historical and archaeological items, including Louis and Mary Leakey's findings from Olduvai Gorge.
- The Hall of Man at the National Museum displays human fossils, including the skull of the Nutcracker Man.
- The National Museum also has a collection of tribal ornaments, headdresses, witchcraft paraphernalia, and traditional musical instruments from various regions in Tanzania.
- Note that the National Museum is not air-conditioned.
- The tour starts and ends in Dar es Salaam city center.

BAGAMOYO DAY TRIP

Highlights

- Bagamoyo is located 75kms north of Dar es Salaam and takes about an hour to drive there.
- Bagamoyo is the oldest town in Tanzania, being the starting point of slave caravan routes and the terminus of white missionaries.
- Bagamoyo has recently been designated as Tanzania's seventh world heritage site.
- Visitors to Bagamoyo should not miss Kaole Ruins dating back to the earlier part of the 15th century, the first Roman Catholic Church in Tanganyika built by the Germans in the 1880s, and the museum housing numerous historical artifacts.
- Bagamoyo has pristine white sandy beaches where visitors can relax, swim in the clear blue waters, and enjoy a picnic lunch before returning to the mainland.
- Visitors can subcontract boat trips to the Ruvu River Delta from where they can catch glimpses of hippos, birdlife, and several species of mangroves.
- Visitors should plan to be back at their hotel in Dar by 4.00 pm.

BONGOYO ISLAND DAY TRIP FROM DAR ES SALAAM- SLIPWAY

Highlights

- Bongoyo Island is an uninhabited island in Tanzania, located 2.5km north of Dar es Salaam.
- It is the most frequently visited of the four islands of the Dar es Salaam Marine Reserve (DMRS) and is popular for snorkelling and sunbathing.
- The island can be reached by means of a 30 minute boat ride from the mainland, with the point of departure being 'The Slipways' hotel complex on the western side of the Msasani Peninsula.
- Bongoyo Island has a very rocky shore and only two beaches. Visitors typically visit the beach at the northwestern tip of the island, where the boats moor and where there are some huts, drinks and food.
- The longer but narrower beach along the northeastern side has no facilities and is mostly deserted.
- The entire island (apart from the beaches) is covered in dense forest and has a few walking trails, but few people venture there.
- Transfers can be arranged from visitors' hotels to Slipway, but bookings have to be made directly with Slipway at www.slipway.net/island_trips.php

ZANZIBAR DAY TRIP

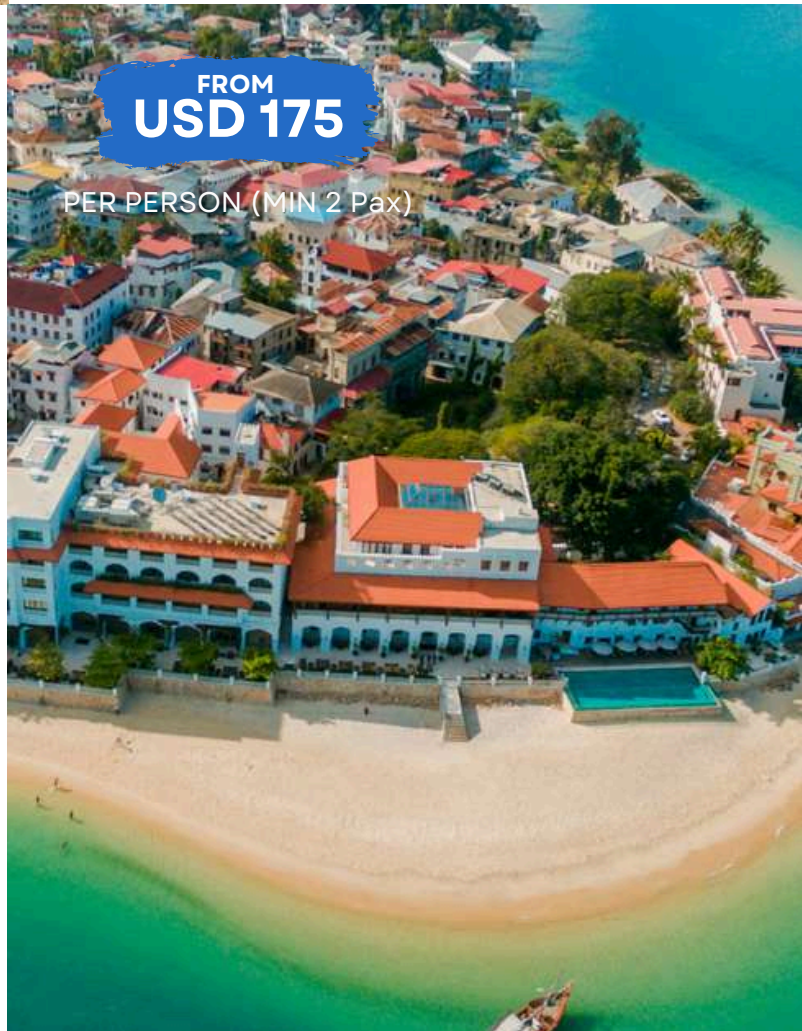
Highlights

- Visitors will have 2 hours to shop around Stone Town on their own.

DHOW TRIP & SNORKELING

- Snorkeling in Dar es Salaam offers a chance to explore the south beaches at Kipepeo Beach, which is only 8 km away from the city centre.
- Daily sailing trips are available for snorkeling and Dhow's excursion to nearby Sinda Island.
- Visitors can be picked up from Dar City Centre and transferred to Kipepeo Beach for the trip.
- The trip usually departs at around 10 am and returns to Kipepeo by 3.30 pm.
- Sinda Island Marine Reserve is a popular destination for snorkeling and island walks.
- Visitors can enjoy a relaxed trip and have lunch on a deserted beach after snorkeling.
- The traditional dhow boat is used for the trip, and visitors can see pods of dolphins accompanying the boat.
- The offshore waters have a diverse range of colorful starfish, tropical fish, and coral reefs, making it an excellent snorkeling spot.

Includes: Transfer to and from Kipepeo Beach, Fuel, marine park fee, picnic lunch, non-alcoholic drinks, and snorkeling equipment

Excludes: Other personal expenses



THEME PARKS

- Depart early in the morning for **Kunduchi Wet 'N' Wild**, the biggest water theme park in East and Central Africa,
- located approximately 20 km North of Dar Es Salaam on Kunduchi Beach.
- Spend an entire day with family and friends enjoying loads of entertainment and fun.
- Kunduchi Wet 'N' Wild opens at 9.30 AM and closes at 6.00 PM.
- Enjoy water slides and ring slides if you like the thrill of fast free-fall.
- Wet n Wild has a separate Jungle Gym play area for children with a wide array of climbing structures.
- Tanzania's One and Only Go Kart Track
- There are three restaurants where visitors can sit in comfortable surroundings for sumptuous meals, and several fast-food outlets allocated in the food court for a quick snack.
- Various beverage outlets are located throughout the park to quench the thirst.
- Various themes and menus are available for groups upon request catering for specific needs.
- After the trip, you will be transferred back to Dar City centre.
